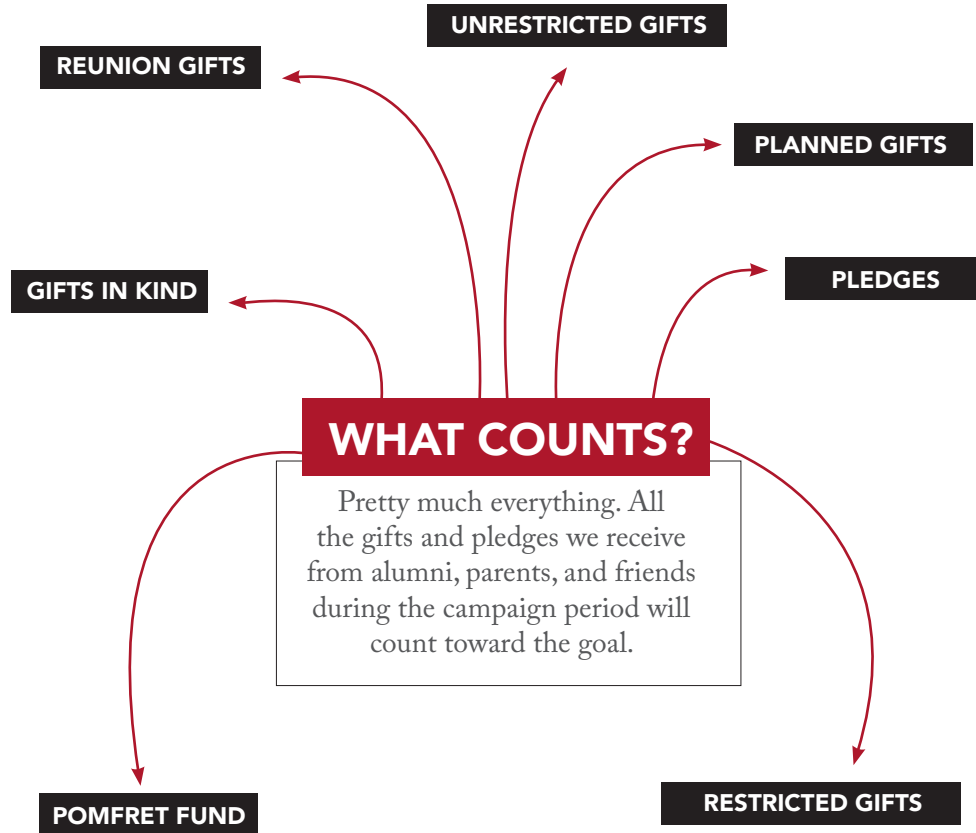
THE GRAUER INSTITUTE

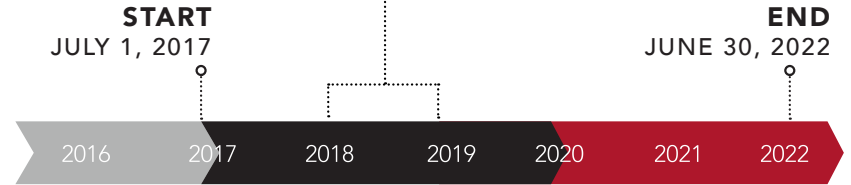


AT A GLANCE

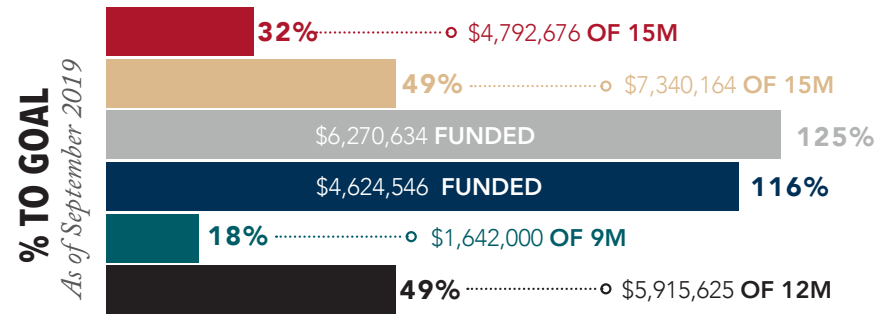

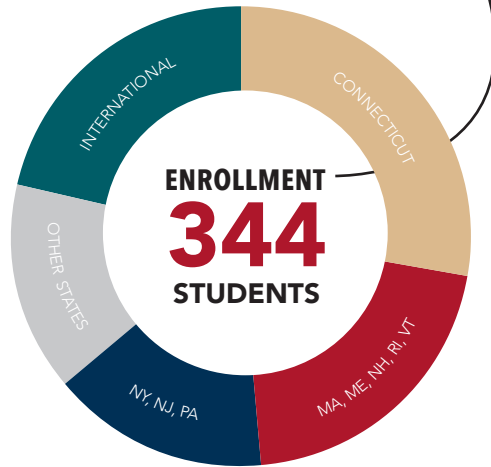

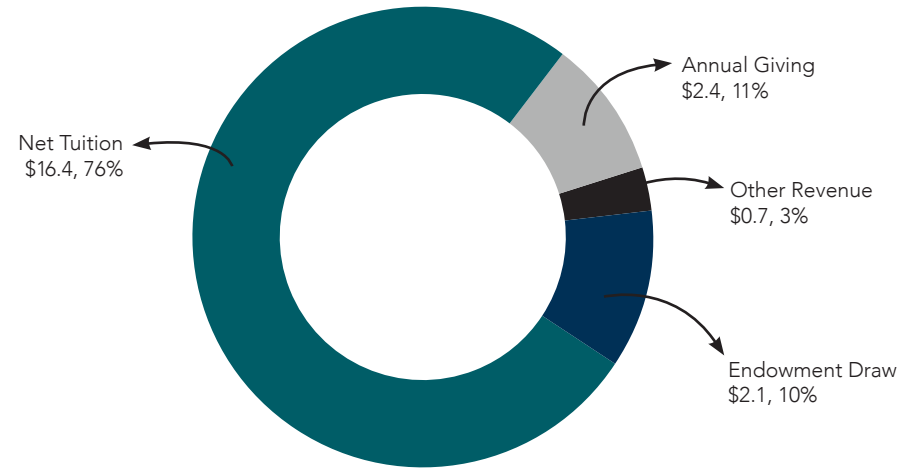

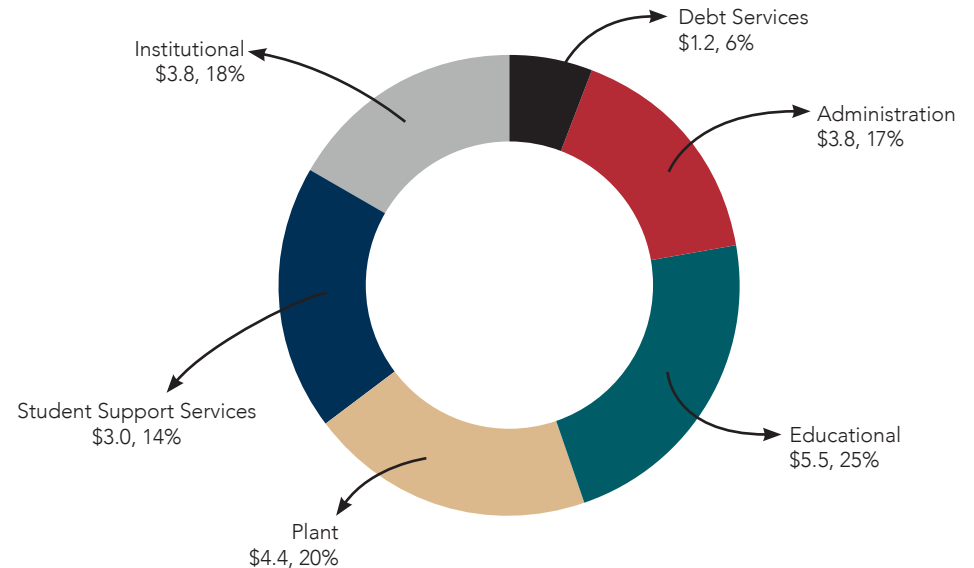
